Aim to have a video around 3 minutes in total length. **Please do not submit videos longer than 3 min. Any recording less than 2 minutes is not accepted. This may affect your enrollment in your ASL course!**
- 2) Your video-recorded responses can be submitted as an .m4v or private YouTube link, which allows me to download. Please make sure that you adjust the permissions on your video.
- 3) Your video recording is due by Monday August 19th, 2019 at 5:00pm. **Late submissions will not be accepted. Again, this may impact your enrollment in your ASL course!**
