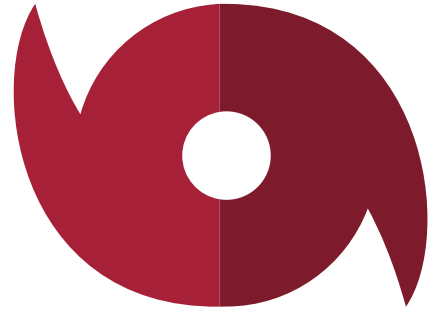


# HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS TIPS

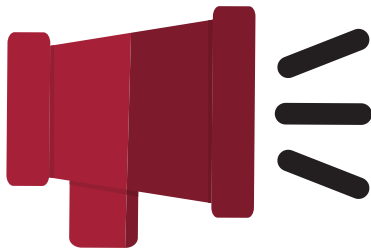
## TROPICAL WEATHER BASICS

- **Tropical Depression:** winds < 39 MPH
- **Tropical Storm:** winds 39 – 73 MPH
- **Hurricane:** winds > 73 MPH
- **Warning:** conditions are expected somewhere within the warning area. A warning is usually issued 36 hours before the onset of the storm's winds.
- **Watch:** conditions are possible within area. A watch is usually issued 48 hours before the onset of the storm's winds.

In the event of an emergency, the college will begin posting advisories and important information through these forms of communication:



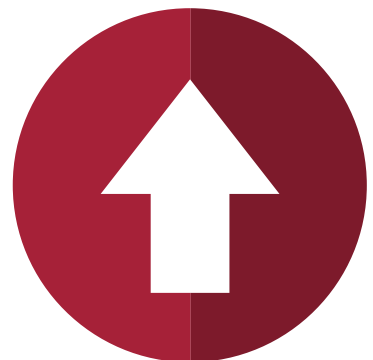

## WHAT IF AN EVACUATION IS ORDERED IN ST. AUGUSTINE?

- You must leave campus immediately as students, faculty and staff will not be allowed to remain on campus.
- Students must sign out before leaving campus and should notify family about plans.
- Flagler will work with students who are in need of transportation.
- St. Johns County Emergency Management officials will open designated shelters.
- If possible, evacuate to the home of a friend or a family member instead of a shelter.
- Leave the area early and do not return to the college until told to do so.
