



Demonstration of American Sign Language (ASL) Proficiency for Graduate Programs in Deaf Education

Students must demonstrate ASL proficiency in order to be admitted to the program. Students who do not demonstrate acceptable proficiency are expected to enroll in additional coursework separate from the program curriculum to reach acceptable proficiency at an additional cost to the student. Documentation of ASL proficiency must be submitted with your application. Proficiency interviews can be scheduled through the following programs:
