For this reason, it is crucial that we invest in Flagler Tennis to ensure its continued prominence in the life of the College. A TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE

Flagler's men's and women's tennis programs have played a vital role in the growth, notoriety, and campus life of the College since their inception in 1974.

- The programs have won a combined seven national championships (5 women, 2 men) and numerous conference, district, and regional championships.
- Over the course of their nearly 50-year history, the women's program has won an incredible 71% of all their matches and the men have won more than 65% of theirs.
- Most recently, both the men's and women's teams have won Peach Belt Conference regular season and tournament championships, hosted their respective NCAA Regional tournaments, and advanced to the NCAA Nationals.
- The women's team advanced to the 2022 Elite Eight and concluded their season with a record of 19-8, while the men were 20-6 and went to the Final Four.

• In 2023, the men's team advanced to Elite Eight while sporting a 19-7 overall record. The women's team advanced to the Final Four and concluded the season with a record of 22-5.


