TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION AMENDMENTS OF 1972

Protects individuals from discrimination based on sex in educational programs and activities, including:

- Sexual harassment and assault
- Dating and domestic violence
- Stalking
- Gender-based harassment
- Discrimination based on pregnancy or parenting

KNOW YOUR OPTIONS

You can:

- Request supportive measures
- File a formal complaint
- Request an informal resolution process
- Choose not to participate in an investigation

To encourage reporting:

- Retaliation is against college policy
- Students will receive amnesty for minor policy violations at the time of the incident
