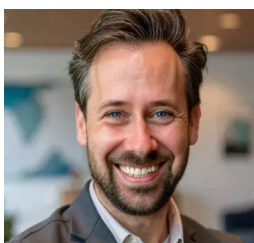


MESSAGE FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR
