Explore why people think, feel, and act the way they do through hands-on research and internships, building the critical thinking and communication skills that open doors in nearly any career.

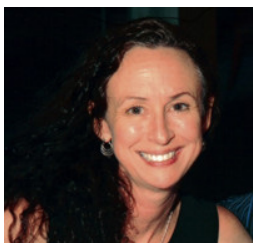


MESSAGE FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR
