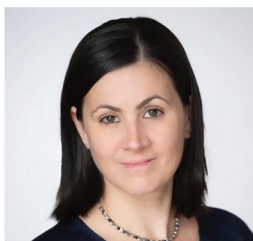


MESSAGE FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR

THE ART OF CABARET

Students train in cabaret. They perform a group cabaret every year and create individual work of their own. Flagler partners with 54 Below, New York City's acclaimed off-Broadway cabaret club, where students have brought their own cabaret on multiple occasions.

CAPSTONE SHOWCASE

Every major concludes their program with a professional acting showcase or portfolio presentation.

STUDY AWAY, SUMMER LONG

Students have the opportunity to gain internship credit over the summer by working with theatre companies all over the country.

PLAYWRIGHTS SYMPOSIUM

Many of Flagler's top actors, playwrights, and managers have the chance to work with Pulitzer, Tony, and Oscar-winning playwrights and industry professionals at the National Playwrights Symposium.
